### About EU Reintegration Programme

The EU Reintegration Programme ensures the provision of reintegration assistance to returnees departing on a voluntary or non-voluntary basis from Member States and Schengen Associated Countries to their countries of origin. At the same time, it contributes to an effective return policy in the European Union, ensuring that returns are done in a dignified and humane manner. To implement this assistance, Frontex has concluded a partnership with IRARA who cooperates with *Syrian Society for Social Development (SSSD) in Syria* to ensure the deliverance of high level of support.



### About SSSD

IRARA collaborates with Syrian Society for Social Development (SSSD) for the delivery of expert reintegration services in Syria. SSSD has been providing aid and services for displaced Syrian nationals since its inception in 2009 and provides an effective response to the needs and challenges of Syrian people. Working throughout Syria, IRARA and SSSD offer tailored, trustworthy and professional reintegration assistance to individuals and families returning to Syria at all times putting the needs of the returnee first.

- Long-term housing support
- Social, legal and medical support
- Job placement assistance
- Schooling and language training
- Technical and vocational training
