About Joint Reintegration Services

The Joint Reintegration Services is at the core of the Frontex Reintegration Programme. It provides for the provision of reintegration assistance to returnees departing on a voluntary or non-voluntary basis from Member States and Schengen Associated Countries to their countries of origin. At the same time, it contributes to an effective return policy in the European Union, ensuring that returns are done in a dignified and humane manner. To implement this assistance, Frontex has concluded a partnership with IRARA who cooperates with BRAC in Bangladesh to assure the deliverance of high level of support.



About BRAC

IRARA collaborates with BRAC for the delivery of the JRS reintegration programme in Bangladesh. BRAC has been creating opportunities for people and driving social and economic transformation across Bangladesh since 1972. Together with IRARA they have extensive experience in resettling citizens and providing advice and support for successful reintegration. Over the last five years over 28,000 returning individuals have accessed reintegration services such as social counselling, skills training, financial support and referrals provided by BRAC.
