The Joint Reintegration Services is at the core of the Frontex Reintegration Programme. It provides for the provision of reintegration assistance to returnees departing on a voluntary or non-voluntary basis from Member States and Schengen Associated Countries to their countries of origin. At the same time, it contributes to an effective return policy in the European Union, ensuring that returns are done in a dignified and humane manner. To implement this assistance, Frontex has concluded a partnership with **IRARA** who cooperates with **WASDA** in **Kenya** to assure the deliverance of high level of support.

IRARA collaborates with Wajir South Development Association (WASDA) to deliver the JRS Reintegration Services in Kenya. Together IRARA and WASDA have professional counsellors who have extensive experience in resettling citizens in Kenya by providing advice and support for successful and long-term reintegration which is tailored to individual's specific needs.
