About Joint Reintegration Services

The Joint Reintegration Services is at the core of the Frontex Reintegration Programme. It provides for the provision of reintegration assistance to returnees departing on a voluntary or non-voluntary basis from Member States and Schengen Associated Countries to their countries of origin. At the same time, it contributes to an effective return policy in the European Union, ensuring that returns are done in a dignified and humane manner. To implement this assistance, Frontex has concluded a partnership with IRARA who cooperates with GREDO in SOMALIA to assure the deliverance of high level of support.



About GREDO

IRARA collaborates with GREDO (Gargaar Relief and Development Organisation) for the delivery of the reintegration services. GREDO is an indigenous local NGO and is focused on community development and rehabilitation including enhancing conditions and providing durable solutions for internal displaced persons and returnees in Somalia. GREDO and IRARA deliver services for returnees across Somalia, rebuilding livelihoods and driving sustainable reintegration.
