About Joint Reintegration Services

The Joint Reintegration Services is at the core of the Frontex Reintegration Programme. It provides for the provision of reintegration assistance to returnees departing on a voluntary or non-voluntary basis from Member States and Schengen Associated Countries to their countries of origin. At the same time, it contributes to an effective return policy in the European Union, ensuring that returns are done in a dignified and humane manner. To implement this assistance, Frontex has concluded a partnership with IRARA who cooperates with CIES in TUNISIA to assure the deliverance of high level of support.



About CIES

IRARA collaborates with the 'Centre d'Information et d'éducation pour le developpement – Section Tunisie' (CIES Tunisie) for the delivery of reintegration services in Tunisia. CIES's interventions cover migration, socio-economic integration of vulnerable populations, linguistic and intercultural mediation, and raising awareness of intercultural dialogue. Together with IRARA, CIES provides assistance and support to returning individuals and families in Tunisia tailored to their specific needs
