About Joint Reintegration Services

The Joint Reintegration Services is at the core of the Frontex Reintegration Programme. It provides for the provision of reintegration assistance to returnees departing on a voluntary or non-voluntary basis from Member States and Schengen Associated Countries to their countries of origin. At the same time, it contributes to an effective return policy in the European Union, ensuring that returns are done in a dignified and humane manner. To implement this assistance, Frontex has concluded a partnership with **IRARA** who cooperates with **COWOYEM** in **NIGERIA** to assure the deliverance of high level of support.



About COWOYEM

IRARA collaborates with Concern for Women and Youth Empowerment (COWOYEM) for the delivery of reintegration services. COWOYEM is focused on community development and delivering sustainable reintegration for returnees to Nigeria. COWOYEM and IRARA assist returnees by providing advice and support for successful and long-term reintegration, tailored to individual's needs.
