## Returning to Ghana



### Information Leaflet



#### WHAT ASSISTANCE CAN BE PROVIDED?

##### Pre-Departure Information:

- Returning individuals whilst in the UK can contact IRARA to discuss reintegration options in Ghana.

##### Assistance on Arrival:

- Meet & Greet at the airport.
- Accommodation for up to five nights.
- Onward transportation to an address in-country.
- Care / hygiene packs.
- Covid-19 testing (if required).
- Cash assistance to meet immediate needs.

##### In-Country Support:

- Assistance with tracing and reuniting with family.
- Support with in-country documentation.
- Signposting to local services.
- Support with accessing local health services.
- Mental wellbeing and counselling (if required).

##### Economic assistance:

- Support with accessing the job market.
- Support with setting up a business.
- Support with accessing vocational training or further education.
- Access to an Education and Entrepreneurship Fund.
- Assistance with legal migration opportunities.

##### Who can get Support?

If you are a Ghanaian national and have been returned to Ghana or will be returned from the United Kingdom, IRARA can help you rebuild your life in Ghana.

This support is available for up to 18 months following your return to Ghana.

If you are currently in the UK, contact the UK IRARA office using the details below.

If you have already returned to Ghana, please contact the IRARA representative in Accra using the details below.

##### About the Programme:

The Home Office Reintegration Programme assists the return and reintegration of those who have no legal right to remain in the United Kingdom.

The programme offers a wide range of services, providing assistance on arrival and longer-term support for persons returning to Ghana.
